



## **SECTION 1. CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP.**

**A. RESIDENT MEMBERS** – Resident Members shall be only those persons who have attained the age of twenty-five years and who reside, or have a summer residence, ashore or afloat, in Queen Anne's County or any county contiguous thereto. The number of such members shall not exceed 200.

**B. FAMILY MEMBERS** – Family Members shall be only spouses, or children over the age of 7 years and under the age of 18 years, of Resident Members.

**C. ASSOCIATE MEMBERS** – Associate Members shall be only those persons who have attained the age of 18 years, and who have not attained the age of 25 year. The number of such members shall not exceed 100.

**D. JUNIOR MEMBERS** – Junior Members shall be only those persons who have attained the age of 8 years, and who have not attained the age of 18 years, and who are not children of resident members. The number of such members shall not exceed 50.

**E. NON-RESIDENT MEMBERS** – Non-Resident Members shall be only those persons who have previously been Resident Members of the Club for a period of not less than two years and who currently have no residence, permanent or temporary, ashore or afloat, in Queen Anne's County or any county contiguous thereto. The number of such members shall not exceed 50. Such members are expected not to use this membership for the purpose of avoiding the membership requirements of other Clubs or otherwise abusing the reciprocal courtesies extended by other Clubs to Corsica River Yacht Club members.

**F. INTERIM MEMBERS** – Interim Members shall be only those persons who are former members of some other membership classification for which they are no longer eligible, and who have been properly approved for membership in a new classification but who cannot immediately receive such membership because of the existence of a waiting list. Such persons shall pay the dues of the new class of membership for which they have been approved and shall enjoy all privileges of such membership except for voting and holding office. The names of all such persons shall be placed upon a waiting list, and when an opening appears in the new membership classification they shall be received into such classification upon the payment of such initiation fee, if any, and the making of such capital subscription, if any, as may be then in effect. Interim members shall be received into their new membership classification ahead of applicants who are not former members of some other classification
